

## Thirty One Days of Scriptural Prayer for Israel

<p>Day 1 Psalm 122:6,7. "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee. Pray also that peace be within Jerusalem's walls, and prosperity within her palaces.</p> <p>Day 2. Isaiah 43:5,6 Jeremiah 16:14,15. Pray for the continued regathering of the Jewish people to Eretz Yisrael, the land of Israel, from throughout the world. Pray that the Jews will be stirred in their spirits to make "aliyah," to return to the land.</p> <p>Day 3. Isaiah 60:1-5; Revelation 21:24,27 Pray that the ancient calling of the Jewish people to be a "light to the nations" will come alive in their hearts. Pray that this will be a constant reminder of the danger of indulging in the sins of the nations.</p> <p>Day 4. Ezekiel 34:27-31. Pray that Israel will recognize her God who loves her and who is the only real guarantee of her security and continued existence, and that they shall KNOW that they are His people.</p> <p>Day 5. Hosea 4:12; Ezekiel 36:25 Pray that Israel will be cleansed from all idols; that she will forsake all her lovers and return to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.</p> <p>Day 6. Isaiah 62:6,7; II Corinthians 10:3-5. Pray that the strongholds of religious legalism, secularism, and humanism will be pulled down in Israel and throughout the worldwide Jewish community.</p> <p>Day 7. Galatians 3:6-9; Ezekiel 34:13,14. Pray that God will give the Jews the gift of faith that will enable them to look beyond the sacrifices that they must make and return to the land of Israel.</p> <p>Day 8. Isaiah 62:11,12; Romans 11:26. Pray Israel's salvation comes forth and "all Israel will be saved."</p> <p>Day 9. Luke 17:28-30; Titus 2:11-14. Pray for the deliverance of the Jews from social and moral decay that is widespread in Israel.</p> <p>Day 10. Ephesians 6:12,18; Matthew 18:18. Pray that the stronghold of anti-Semitism, demonic hatred for the Jewish people, will be broken and pulled down. Pray that the stronghold of Islam will be pulled down throughout Israel and around the world.</p> <p>Day 11. Isaiah 29:13; James 4:8, 13-16. Pray that the Jewish people will turn more and more to God and separate themselves from double-mindedness and trusting in their own ability.</p> <p>Day 12. Jeremiah 6:10; Acts 7:51; Romans 10-13. Pray that the uncircumcised ears of the Jewish people will be opened to hear and obey God's Word; to delight in God's Word and no longer be rebellious.</p> <p>Day 13. Romans 9:17; Ezekiel 36:26,27. Pray that Israel will discover the power of God; that they will hunger and thirst for God and His Word and receive it into their hearts.</p> <p>Day 14. Genesis 14:29,20; Genesis 17:19; Deuteronomy 6:10; Galatians 4:28. Pray that the people of Israel will look past the ever-increasing threats of war and terrorism from surrounding Arab nations and fanatic Islamic groups and look to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.</p> <p>Day 15. Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Deuteronomy 11:18-21. Pray that the Lord would circumcise the hearts of their seed so that they will love the Lord their God with all their souls; that they may live unto Him.</p>	<p>Day 16. Psalm 91:9-12; Psalm 122:6,7. Pray as never before for Israel's security and physical welfare.</p> <p>Day 17. Ezekiel 11:19,20. Pray that God will take the stony heart out of them and give them a heart of flesh.</p> <p>Day 18. Romans 11:23,24; II Corinthians 3:14; II Corinthians 4:4. Pray that the unbelief of the Jewish people will be taken away; that they will be grafted in again into their own olive tree. Pray also that the veil will be lifted from their eyes, minds and hearts.</p> <p>Day 19. Romans 11:17-20; Zechariah 12:9. Pray that the strongholds of pride and high mindedness in the Church against the Jewish people will be pulled down and that the Church will see the truth and take action.</p> <p>Day 20. Romans 11:30,31. Pray that the Church will be filled with mercy and love for the Jewish people and begin to pray for their protection and salvation.</p> <p>Day 21. Psalm 35:4; Psalm 129:5. Pray that God will cause all those who hate Israel to be confused and turn back.</p> <p>Day 22. Romans 11:11; Matthew 5:14. Pray that the Christians' light will shine and that they will provoke the Jews to jealousy.</p> <p>Day 23. Zechariah 2:10-12. Pray that the Lord will hasten the day when He shall inherit Judah, His portion in the Holyland, and when He shall choose Jerusalem again.</p> <p>Day 24. Zechariah 12:10,12. Pray, "O Lord God, hasten the day that they shall look upon Messiah Jesus whom they have pierced and mourn for Him as one who mourns for His only Son".</p> <p>Day 25. Zechariah 13:1,2; Joel 2:28,29. Pray for the fountain of Israel to be restored; to be open to the saturating rain of God's Holy Spirit ( His Ruach Hakodesh).</p> <p>Day 26. Isaiah 62:1-3. Pray that the Lord will hasten the day that the nations will see Israel's righteousness and glory and she will have a new name and be a crown of beauty in His hand and a royal diadem in the hand of her God.</p> <p>Day 27. II Timothy 5:8; Titus 2:13,14. Pray that Christians and Jews would love and desire the day of Messiah's appearing.</p> <p>Day 28. Genesis 12:2,3; Genesis 28:3,4; Isaiah 40:1,2. Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead the Church into understanding and acting upon the scriptural commands to bless and comfort Israel and the Jewish people.</p> <p>Day 29. Galatians 3:28,29. Pray that God will open the door for us to minister to Christians and Jews so that their hearts would be open to receive the teachings of the love of the Father, that the Father's heart is for them to come together to share His love and salvation.</p> <p>Day 30. Ezekiel 36:26,27. Pray that God will put within the Jewish people a new heart and spirit, and cause them to walk in His statutes and heed His ordinances. Pray that His people will dwell in the land He gave their fathers and be His people, allowing Him to truly be their God.</p> <p>Day 31. Jeremiah 16:14,15; I Timothy 2:1,2. Pray for the Jews that are coming back to their homeland, that provision will be made for them as they return; that those in authority would turn to God, and that Jewish people and all Israel may lead a quiet and peaceable life.</p>
